

IMPLEMENTATION OF INTEGRITY PACT

HSCC (India) Limited has adopted Integrity pact (IP) for all contracts valuing Rs.5 Crores and above to ensure transparency, impartiality and competitiveness in its procurements/ tenders.

The IP envisages an agreement between the bidders/Contractors/vendors and HSCC (the principle) committing that the persons/officials of both the parties shall not resort to any corrupt, unfair practices during the tendering process and contract execution. The submission of signed IP shall be a preliminary qualification for submitting the bid and entering any contract with HSCC.

The details regarding the applicability, submission and signing of the IP are specified in the Bidding/Tender Documents for respective Projects/Work/Services.

The independent External Monitors (IEMs) would monitor the bidding process and execution of contract. IEMs shall be accountable for the implementation of Integrity Pact Programme to prevent corruption, bribery or any other unethical/unfair practices.
