1	Page 10, General Terms and Conditions: Clause Number 36 states that, "The bidder should not have incurred any loss in the last three years ending 31st March 2017. This should be duly certified by a Chartered Accountant".  The above clause makes the contract totally non-inclusive for new entrants that have made big investments in this business to bring Indian hospital Laundry at par with international standards. To make the contract more inclusive we will suggest that while this clause may be retained for all companies that may be 5 years or older, there needs to be an addition of either/or clause to this clause which permits new companies with big investment to be able to participate in the tender.  We would request that for a new company like ours and given our investment size of more than 100 crores for this plant, it is not feasible for such companies to be in profit in such a short span. I would request this be taken in consideration while there is still some time for applying for the tender. Though we have a turnover of more than 30 crores a year in just the 3nd year of operation, given our amortisation of the huge assets that we have put in the plant we will	Tender terms and conditions prevail.
2	Page number 3: Schedule-A: Clause 8 of this schedule requires the contract to be executed within 10 days of the intimation of the acceptance of the rates. We had raised this issue in the pre-bid meeting that this is a very short duration to source the linen that is required to be provided to Safdarjung as per Table 2, page number 31 and 32 of the tender document. We will suggest that of the tender need to be executed at such a short notice then the committee need to take in consideration the linen that is readily available. We are engaged in offering laundry service including linen rental throughout India, but currently we are not providing linen rental service in Delhi but we have got the expertise & experience to execute your requirement. Hence, we request you to modify the qualification criteria to include laundry service

5	As per point no.2 (Annexure-II) Page-37 starting of services in 15 days from award of contract is impractical and involves manufacturing & supply of linen as per Table -3 on Page no.34, which takes time for production, hence we request you to provide minimum 45 days for starting the services from date of award. From 30 <sup>th</sup> date from notification of Award bidders have to provide the linen as specified in tender specification.
