In context of above Provison, it needs to be mentioned that for purpose of evaluation of Tender, it needs to be clarified that if any bidder-Laboratory has served 300 bedded hospital for 3 years and also got such Lab NABL accredited, albeit for shorter duration than 3 years, whether same shall qualify Technical bid .In other words, experience of serving 300 bedded hospital for 3 years as well as getting such Lab NABL accreditated (irrespective of duration) should suffice for qualification, instead of insistence on duration of NABL of such Lab for 300 bedded hospital, as additional eligibility criterion. In this regards, it needs to be mentioned that <i>Para 11/Page 31</i> of General condition to the Tenderer (GTT) has already specified it as mandatory eligibility criterion " <i>Bidder/Firm/Laboratory should have NABL Accreditation for 3 years, with experience in Pathology, Microbiology, Bio-chemistry</i> ". 	for NABL (with respect to bidder's Lab in 300 bedded Hospital-partnership) seems unnecessary and severely restrictive, while defining 'similar works' in Para 2.2(ii)/Page8. Simultaneous reading of both Proviso to Para 2.2(ii) (Top of Page 8) in conjunction with Para 11/Page 31 reveals that on one hand, Safdarjung Hospital desires original/mother Laboratory itself as NABL for 3 years, while it simultaneously desires such lab to have additional eligibility criterion of having carried on similar works for some other 300 bedded hospital as NABL for 3 years. Ideally, by common sense, Duration of NABL for 'similar works' by Bidder for other 300 bedded hospital, should have been lesser than Duration of NABL of original/mother Laboratory itself of bidder. This shall render most of vendors ineligible. Needless to say, such unnecessarily restrictive condition shall significantly reduce participation in said Tender, leading to inferior price discovery and cause huge financial losses to Govt of India over next 5 years. Hence, in view of above discussions, in definition of "Similar work" in said Proviso to Para 2.2(ii) needs to be either deleted or even if kept so, 3 year duration of NABL should not be insisted for experience with such 300 bedded hospital. In view of above discussion, it is requested to modify said proviso to Para 2.2(ii)/Page 8 as following –(Suggested wording of proviso to Para 2.2(ii)) " *Similar nature of works means serving/served Laboratory Diagnostic Facility satisfactorily in 300 bedded Hospital for minimum 3 years, and such facility must have got NABL Accreditation, at revenent efficient"

	In context of above Provison, it needs to be mentioned that for purpose of evaluation of Tender, it needs to be clarified that if any bidder-Laboratory has served 300 bedded hospital for 3 years and also got such Lab NABL accredited, albeit for shorter duration than 3 years, whether same shall qualify Technical bid .In other words, experience of serving 300 bedded hospital for 3 years as well as getting such Lab NABL accreditated (irrespective of duration) should suffice for qualification, instead of insistence on duration of NABL of such Lab for 300 bedded hospital, as additional eligibility criterion.	
	In this regards, it needs to be mentioned that <i>Para 11/Page</i> 31 of General condition to the Tenderer (GTT) has already specified it as mandatory eligibility criterion "Bidder/Firm/Laboratory should have NABL Accreditation for 3 years, with experience in Pathology, Microbiology, Bio-chemistry". In duplication to same, insistence of additional eligibility criterion of minimum 3 year duration for NABL (with respect to bidder's Lab in 300 bedded	

Hospital-partnership) seems unnecessary and severely	
<i>restrictive</i> , while defining 'similar works' in Para 2.2(ii)/Page8.	
Simultaneous reading of both <i>Proviso to Para 2.2(ii) (Top of Page 8)</i> in conjunction with <i>Para 11/Page 31</i> reveals that on one hand, Safdarjung Hospital desires original/mother Laboratory itself as NABL for 3 years, while it simultaneously desires such lab to have additional eligibility criterion of having carried on <i>similar works</i> for some other 300 bedded hospital as NABL for 3 years. Ideally, by common sense, Duration of NABL for 'similar works' by Bidder for other 300 bedded hospital, should have been lesser than Duration of NABL of original/mother Laboratory itself of bidder. This shall render most of vendors ineligible.	
Needless to say, such unnecessarily restrictive condition shall significantly reduce participation in said Tender, leading to inferior price discovery and cause huge financial losses to Govt of India over next 5 years. Hence, in view of above discussions, in definition of "Similar work" in said Proviso to Para 2.2.(ii) needs to be either deleted or even if kept so, 3 year duration of NABL should not be insisted for experience with such 300 bedded hospital.	
In view of above discussion, it is requested to modify said provison to Para 2.2(ii)/Page 8 as following –(Suggested wording of provison to Para 2.2(ii)) " *Similar nature of works means serving/served Laboratory Diagnostic Facility satisfactorily in 300 bedded Hospital for minimum 3 years, and such facility must have got NABL Accreditation, at some point of time"	
Suggested modification will result in widespread participation in such prestigious tender and lead to far better price discovery as well as saving of huge financial resources of Ministry of Health.
