<b>Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) 19.2</b>	The tenderers who are currently registered and, also, will continue to remain registered during the tender validity period with Directorate General of Supplies & Disposals or with National Small Industries Corporation, New Delhi for the specific goods as per tender enquiry specification shall be eligible for exemption from EMD. Vague stipulations in the Registration Certificate such as “to customers’ specification” etc. will not be acceptable for exemption from furnishing of earnest money. In case the tenderer falls in these categories, it should furnish copy of its valid registration details (with DGS&D or NSIC, as the case may be)	The tenderers who are currently registered and, also, will continue to remain registered during the tender validity period as Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) as defined in MSE Procurement Policy issued by Department of Micro, small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) or with National Small Industries Corporation, New Delhi shall be eligible for exemption from the EMD. . In case the tenderer falls in this category, it should furnish copy of its valid registration details (with MSME or NSIC, as the case may be)

All other terms and conditions of the tender enquiry documents shall remain unchanged.
