GENERAL CONDITIONS TO THE TENDERER (GIT)

1. **Please read the terms and conditions before filling the tender form.**
2. Bidder must assess business before participating in tender.
3. Firm should not be blacklisted/debarred from participating in tender by any Government institution.
4. The tender for (**Annexure-1**) should be clearly filled and no column should be left blank.
5. Each paper of the tender document uploaded online must be signed by the tenderer with seal of Agency/Firm and pages numbered.
6. Bidder will be abiding by all the terms and conditions of tender document. An undertaking as per **Annexure-III** should be submitted in this regard.
7. PRICE BID OF ONLY THOSE TENDERERS WHO ARE FOUND TO BE QUALIFIED IN PREQUALIFICATION WILL BE OPENED. Date and time will be informed through website, e-mail and registered letter. Bidder wishing to present on the occasion may attend the same.
8. All the documents of the firm and details of Laboratory uploaded by the tenderer should bear the same name and address.
9. The bidder shall deposit Bid Security (Earnest Money Deposit) for an amount of Rs.5.00 lakhs (Rupees Five Lakhs Only) in the form of Bank Guarantee/FDR/DD issued in favour of Medical Superintendent, Safdarjung Hospital New Delhi drawn on any scheduled/nationalized bank payable at Delhi/Noida. The bid security will remain valid for a period of six months. Bid securities of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned to them at the earliest after the expiry of the final bid validity and latest on or before 30 days after the award of the contract. The EMD of successful bidder will be adjusted towards Performance security. No interest on EMD deposited will be charged by the bidder.

The tenders shall remain valid for acceptance for a period of 120 days (One hundred and twenty days) after the date of tender opening prescribed in the TE document. Any tender valid for a shorter period shall be treated as unresponsive and rejected.

In exceptional cases, the tenderers may be requested to extend the validity of their tenders up to a specified period. Such request(s) and responses thereto shall be conveyed by surface mail or by fax/ telex/cable followed by surface mail. 12. General Conditions of Contract

ANNEXURE-II

1. Any person who is in Government service or an employee of the department should not be a partner to the contract by the bidder directly or indirectly in any manner whatsoever.
2. The Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up shall have to arrange for the collection and transportation of the samples from the Hospital to Hospital Laboratory at his own cost. The collection and transportation everyday should be under ideal conditions specific for the samples and as per prescribed norms of accreditation. Routine samples drawn/obtained from **OPD & IPD of patients** must be collected from 8.30 AM to 3PM. Report should be despatched within 24 hours. Every day and in case of any emergency investigations the samples must be collected as and when informed telephonically round the clock. The contact number of the Bidder/Firm/Tenderer for this purpose shall have to be furnished in his tender. **Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up** shall have to provide vacutainers/containers for all samples outsourced. The samples are to be received along with requisite requisition slips. **All consumables required will be arranged by the service provider.**
3. **The firm should quote unit rates per test as per CGHS/lower for the tests indicated in the document. Bids will be evaluated based on the average cost calculated based on the total unit cost of all tests divided by total no. Of tests.**
4. Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up is responsible for testing the samples of all OPD/IPD patients. Services to **CGHS** and BPL patients will be provided only if the required test is/ are not available in the institutional laboratory.
5. The service to BPL patients will be provided free of cost on the recommendation of Safdarjung Hospital.
6. **For CGHS patients, the firm will claim reimbursement from CGHS.**
7. The space for running the Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up will be provided by the institute (Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi) in the hospital premises. The furnishing of the laboratory will be done by the Bidder/Firm. The water and electricity bill will be paid by the Bidder/Firm.
8. Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi will allow use of electricity and water for which service provider will pay consumption charges as per prevailing rules of energy supplier Service provider will apply for the installation of separate electric meter in its name and the installation charges for such a connection will be borne by the service provider. The service provider will make payment of energy consumed for the diagnostic facility directly to energy supplier as per rules.
9. The Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up should be made fully operational maximum by 4 weeks (including lab furnishing, installation of equipments) as the hospital is going to function soon.
10. All the CGHS listed tests (as provided in Annexure-IV) have to be carried out in the provided laboratory premises of the institute. The performance of the laboratory will be under the supervision of the respective departments of Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi.
11. The report should contain the name of **respective deptt. Of Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi.**
12. The Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up will have to send/deliver the reports within the suitable turnaround time. In emergency case reports may also be asked/communicated telephonically and to be followed by delivery of written reports, the reports shall have to be prepared in duplicate out of which one copy should be delivered to the patient and the second copy shall be kept as records in the set-up.

13. The data generated through the laboratory covered in this contract will be the intellectual property of the institute (Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi). All equipment will be connected with HIMS and PACS system available in the institute to have the facility of data/ report availability online, hence the equipment to be provided should HIMS and PACS compliant.
14. The disposal of the biomedical waste generated during collection of samples in the hospital should be done as per State Pollution Control Committee and will be the responsibility of the Bidder.
15. **The firm must be running satisfactorily at least one NABL accredited Laboratory anywhere in India in the last 5 years.**
16. **Quality Control Data validation and Reporting for Laboratories will be done by the respective Lab. Department Doctors of Safdarjung Hospital on daily basis.**
17. The Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up must continue to remain accredited during the term/tenure of the contract. If accreditation is cancelled during the contact period, his contract will also be cancelled without any notice.
18. **Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up in the Hospital must be NABL accredited within one year of setting-up and continued to do so throughout the term of the contract.**
19. The Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up will submit an undertaking that the charges quoted are not higher than they have quoted in any Government Hospital.
20. In every case in which by virtue of the provisions of the Workman's Compensation Act, the Government of India is obliged to pay compensation to such person employed by the bidder in execution of the work, the Institute/Government will be entitled to recover from the Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up the amount of compensation so paid.
21. The Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up shall indemnify the Department against all other damages/charges and expenses for which the Government may be held liable or pay on account of the negligence of the Laboratory or his servants or any person under his control whether in respect of accident, injury to the person or damages to the property of any member of the public or any person or in executing the work or otherwise and against all claims and demands thereof.
22. **For Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up the contract will be awarded initially for a period of Five years extendable for further two years on the same terms & conditions, on mutual consent of both the parties and satisfactory performance of the bidder.**
23. Medical Superintendent, Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi (MS) or person authorised by MS, reserves the right to terminate the contract without assigning any reason by giving to the bidder one calendar months' notice, the contract shall come to an end without prejudice for any right of remedy that may be accrued to other party by reason of any incident which of any terms thereof. Such notice may be signed on behalf of Medical Superintendent, Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi. **If after one month notice the firm does not vacate the premises of Safdarjung Hospital, penalty @Rs.50,000/- per day will be imposed on the firm.**
24. If any information documents furnished by Bidder are found to be incorrect/fake/forged at any time, the contract shall be terminated without any notice and the Performance Security will be forfeited.
25. In case the Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up fails to commence/ execute the work as stipulated in the agreement or there is a breach of any terms and condition of the contract, Medical Superintendent (MS) or person authorised by MS, reserves the right to impose the penalty as detailed below:-
 - (i) 2% of the expected expenditure per week, up to 4 weeks.
 - (ii) After 4 weeks, Medical Superintendent, Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi (MS) or person authorised by MS, reserves the right to cancel the contract and withhold the agreement and get this job carried out through other agencies. The defaulting

bidder will be black listed and attract penal action as per clause stated in (i) above and difference if any, will be recovered from the bidder.

(iii) The Performance Security deposited by the Agency will be forfeited.

- 26. The bidder/firm/tenderer shall quote directly. Bidding through partnership/consortium /sub-contracting is not allowed.**
27. The Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up has to maintain all the relevant records, registers and documents are required by the Labour Department Regional Provident Fund Commission and Employees State Insurance Corporation or other local bodies/ Govt. bodies as per the existing rules or as amended from time to time.
28. In case of any violation of statutory provision under Labour laws /BMW rules or otherwise on behalf of the bidder, there will not be any liability on Hospital Authority.
29. In the event of any dispute arising in connection with the interpretation of any clause in the terms and condition of contract, agreement, or otherwise the matter shall be referred to the Medical Superintendent, Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi.
- (i) If any complaint of misbehaviour and misconduct comes into the knowledge of the Medical Superintendent then all such responsibility shall be of the bidder. He will responsible to make good for the losses so suffered by the department. Smoking and consumption of alcohol will be strictly prohibited at the place of work.
Unauthorised financial transactions will be strictly prohibited at the place of work.
30. That the Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up will be responsible for any type of statutory/mandatory claims or penalties arising out of default in results of Investigation.
31. The department shall not be liable to provide any sort of accommodation to the staff or person deployed by the contractor and no cooking/lodging will be allowed in the premises of the Hospital at any time.
32. The Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up shall for providing proper services, ensure the following:
- (ii) Daily worksheet is to be prepared which should tally with results, Missing report of investigation will have to be made available by laboratory at its own cost/effort within reasonable time without inconvenience to patient.
- (iii) That any specific task related to Investigations assigned to the laboratory by the Medical Superintendent or any officer authorized by him is carried out by the bidder diligently and well in time.
- (iv) That any dispute /difference arising out or relating to this contract including the interpretation of the terms will be resolved through discussion and if not so then the matter may be referred to the Medical Superintendent, Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi.
33. The Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up shall seek instruction from Medical Superintendent, Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi or any other officer authorized by him for the purpose, hereinafter referred to as Authorised Officer – **To delete.**
34. The Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up shall also be full responsible for any loss of materials and property etc. of the institute attributable to the negligence or failure in complying with the prescribed procedure. All such losses suffered by the Hospital/Institute on this are compensated in full by the Laboratory.
35. The Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up shall submit the complete documents of the staff deployed for sample collection in the Laboratory which will include Name, Age, Sex, Address, Qualification, Experience Certificate, Medical Fitness, recent photographs, duly attested by the Bidder.
- 36. Staff of the bidder/firm will mark their attendance through biometrix system which will be arranged by the bidder/firm.**
37. The Hospital reserves the right to change the place of duty for collection of sample and also has the right to ask for replacement if a particular Staff is not found to be carrying out the

- functions satisfactorily. The agency will be bound to replace the same within the time period assigned by the Hospital authorities.
38. Only those bidders/firms will be considered qualified who can provide all the tests mentioned in the list. **In case any new test added later by the institute, and at rate decided by M.S., Safdarjung Hospital Administration.**
 39. The Medical Superintendent, Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi reserves the right to cancel the contract agreement or to withhold the payment in the event of non-commencement or unsatisfactory performance of the work contract. In such eventuality, Medical Superintendent (M.S.), Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi further reserves the right to get the work done through some other agencies. Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up will be black listed in the department for a period of four years from participation in such type of tender & his earnest money/performance security may also be forfeited if so warranted.
 40. Payment & accounting:
 - a. Payments for OPD patients will be made directly by the patients.
 - b. Payments for IPD patients will be made at the end of the month by the institute.
 - c. Payment for BPL patients and institute CGHS beneficiaries will be made by the institute at the end of the month Or the tests will be performed by institute laboratory.
 - d. **Payments will be collected by the Cashier of Safdarjung Hospital at the cash counter of Super-Specialty Block, Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi through HIMS, by the firm/bidder.**
 - e. At the end of each month, bill will be cleared within seven days of submission by the service provider (vendor).
 - f. Payment to the service provider (vendor) will be made by the institute after deducting 5% of the net collection amount in favour of the institute as a profit in a PPP mode.

 41. Tax will be paid to the vendor after showing the deposit receipt of the previous month.
 42. All Equipment should be compatible with HIMS/LIS/LAN of the Institute.
 43. Any additional tests which are added later, M.S., Safdarjung Hospital Administration will decide the appropriate rates as per CGHS/prevailing least medical rates.
 44. All the bills to be verified by the Cashier/Accounts Deptt. Of Safdarjung Hospital only and respective deptt. Will have no financial and medico-legal implications therein.
 45. **Resolution of disputes**
 - a. If dispute or difference of any kind shall arise between the Purchaser/Consignee and the supplier in connection with or relating to the contract, the parties shall make every effort to resolve the same amicably by mutual consultations.
 - b. If the parties fail to resolve their dispute or difference by such mutual consultation within twenty-one days of its occurrence, then, unless otherwise provided in the SCC, either the Purchaser/Consignee or the supplier may give notice to the other party of its intention to commence arbitration, as hereinafter provided the applicable arbitration procedure will be as per the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 of India. In the case of a dispute or difference arising between the Purchaser/Consignee and a domestic Supplier relating to any matter arising out of or connected with the contract, such dispute or difference shall be referred to the sole arbitration of an officer in the Ministry of Law and Justice, appointed to be the arbitrator by **Medical Superintendent, Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi**. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties to the contract subject to the provision that the Arbitrator shall give reasoned award in case the value of claim in reference exceeds Rupees One lakhs (Rs. 1,00,000/-)
 - c. Venue of Arbitration: The venue of arbitration shall be the place from where the contract has been issued, i.e., New Delhi, India.

- d. Jurisdiction of the court will be from the place where the tender enquiry document has been issued, i.e., New Delhi, India

46. Applicable Law

The contract shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of India for the time being in force.

47 Withholding and Lien in respect of sums claimed

Whenever any claim for payment arises under the contract against the supplier the purchaser shall be entitled to withhold and also have a lien to retain such sum from the security deposit or sum of money arising out of under any other contract made by the supplier with the purchaser, pending finalization or adjudication of any such claim. It is an agreed term of the contract that the sum of money so withheld or retained under the lien referred to above, by the purchaser, will be kept withheld or retained till the claim arising about of or under the contract is determined by the Arbitrator or by the competent court as the case may be, and the supplier will have no claim for interest or damages whatsoever on any account in respect of such withholding or retention.

LIABILITY OF BIDDER/FIRM/TENDERER

1. The institute shall not be responsible financially or otherwise for any injury & accident to the deployed staff in the course of performing the duty.
2. The Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up shall be liable to make alternate arrangements in case of the absence of any staff deployed for collection of samples. Similarly, the bidder shall have to make alternate arrangements in case of the weekly off. Short leave or meal relief will be permitted to the Laboratory staff deployed when the bidder provides suitable substitute without any extra payment. The bidder has to keep sufficient number of leave reserves.
3. In the event of any breach/violation or contravention of any terms and conditions by the Laboratory Diagnostic Set-up, the said performance security shall be forfeited.
4. The **M.S., Safdarjung Hospital** reserves the right to cancel/reject in full or part of the tender when tenderer does not fulfil the conditions stipulated in the documents.
5. Tenderer submitting a tender will accept all the terms and conditions of the tender.
6. Any act on the part of the tenderer to influence anybody in the institute is liable for rejection of his tender.
7. The agency will have to arrange the Laboratory Investigative Services as per the requirement of hospital authorities. The collection of samples will be strictly as per the guidelines of accreditation and direction of Hospital and relevant BMW rules.
8. The Laboratory shall provide a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs.100/- for preparing a contract agreement and an undertaking as per the enclosed Proforma.
9. The tender will have to comply with all relevant rules / Acts including the provision of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948, the Contract Labour (R&A) Act, 1970 and other legal and statutory requirements, wherever applicable.
10. Every worker/Staff appointed by the bidder for collection of samples shall wear the prescribed uniform. The Bidder will issue Identity Card and a badge bearing his/her name and designation to the worker, which the worker should wear while on duty. The said uniform, Identity Card and badge shall be provided by the contractor at his own cost. The colour of uniform will be decided by hospital authorities and will be intimated to the bidder at the time of assignment of order.
11. That the Bidder staff shall be available all the time as per their duty roster and they shall not leave their place of duty without prior permission.

12. The Bidder will not change any deputed worker during the contract without written information of the Hospital Authority.
13. The Bidder will appoint a qualified PRO/Manager for coordination between the bidder and the Hospital Authorities and should also deal with the public grievances on behalf of bidder.
14. That the Bidder staff shall work under overall supervision and direction of the MS/Hospital's Administration.
15. That the Bidder shall also be responsible to provide all the benefits viz. P.F., ESI, Bonus, Gratuity, Leave etc., to eligible staff engaged by the Laboratory as per relevant rules.
16. That the Bidder will depute only those persons whose antecedents has been verified by the agency and police.
17. The Hospital Authorities shall have the right to ask for the removal of any person of the bidder, who is not found to be competent and orderly in the discharge of his duties.
18. The Bidder staff shall carry out such other duties in the event of fire or any other natural calamities.
19. The Bidder shall not engage any Sub-contractor or transfer the contract to any other person in any manner.
20. Performance Evaluation:
 - (a) The Quality assurance of the Laboratory Investigative Services should be ensured regularly as per requirements of NABL.
 - (b) The staff deployed for collection of samples & transportation will work under the Supervision of the Hospital Authority as per requirement.
 - (c) Appropriate records of all Investigations carried out shall be maintained by the bidder at his own cost and will be handed over to the institute at the end of every month.
21. Bidder will be fully responsible for any damage to the staff engaged by the bidder during duty hours, transportation of sample, reports or due to hazardous handling of the samples collection, transportation etc.
22. Bidder will deploy sufficiently trained (minimum BMLT qualified from reputed Institution) staff for collection of sample Blood and other sample and will provide the relevant equipment along with gloves, spirit, alcohol, swab, vacutainer, needle destroyer, disinfection solution etc. The bidder will also provide stationary for carrying out these tests.
23. **All the staff of the bidder working in the Labs. will report to the respective Doctors In-Charge of the Labs of Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi.**
24. **Attendance of bidder's staff will be on biometrics machine which will be arranged by the bidder.**

Penalty clause

The bidder shall be bound to observe all the instructions issued by the institute concerning general discipline and behaviour. In case any person employed by the bidder is inefficient, quarrelsome, infirm and invalid or indulges in unlawful activities or the like, the bidder shall replace such person with a suitable substitute at the request of the department in light of the provisions referred above. In addition to above, penalties as detailed below can also be imposed on the bidder by the hospital authorities and will be recovered from the monthly bill of the contract period.

1. For misbehaving with patients, officers, staff of institute – Rs.5000/- per default.
2. For non-wearing of proper uniform, badge, ID card: Rs.1000/ per default.
3. For causing nuisance/damage to the hospital properties etc.- Three times the market value of such property or Rs.5000/- whichever is higher.
4. False report or deviation of report beyond acceptable limit as per standard practices- Rs.25,000/- on first instance and termination of contract subsequently and performance security will be forfeited.
5. **For unauthorized financial transaction -Rs.25,000/- on first instance and termination of contract subsequently and performance security will be forfeited.**
