1. Any person who is in Government service or an employee of the department should not be a partner to the contract by the bidder directly or indirectly in any manner whatsoever.
2. Report should be despatched within 24 hours. Every day and in case of any emergency investigations must be done as and when informed telephonically round the clock. The contact number of the Bidder/Firm/Tenderer for this purpose shall have to be furnished in his tender.
All consumables will be arranged by the service provider.
3. Overall single discount offered in % (Over and above minimum 15% discount to be offered on prevalent CGHS rate). Highest discount offered by the service provider will be selected for award.
4. The service provider of Imaging Diagnostic Set-up is responsible for performing imaging of all OPD, IPD and Paid ward patients. Services to **CGHS** and BPL patients will be provided only if the required test is/ are not available in the institutional Diagnostic Imaging Set-up.
5. The service to BPL patients will be provided free of cost on the recommendation of Safdarjung Hospital.
6. **For CGHS patients, the firm will claim reimbursement from CGHS.**
7. The space for running the Diagnostic Imaging Set-up will be provided by the institute (Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi) in the hospital premises. The necessary infrastructure and internal finishing for installation testing, commissioning and running of the Diagnostic Imaging Set-up shall be done by the Bidder/Firm on turnkey basis. The water and electricity bill shall be paid by the Bidder/Firm.
8. Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi will allow use of electricity and water and standby source of power (Generator set capable of catering to the power requirement) and for which service providers shall pay consumption charges as per prevailing rules of energy supplier. Short leave or meal relief will be permitted to the Radio Diagnostic Imaging Set-up staff deployed when the service provider provides suitable substitute without any extra payment. This guarantee shall be in addition to any other guarantee or Security whatsoever that the Employer may now or at any time anywise may have in relation to the Contractor's obligations/or liabilities under and/or in connection with the said Contract, and the Employer shall have full authority to have recourse to or enforce this Security in preference to any other guarantee or Security which the Employer may have or obtain and no forbearance on the part of the Employer in enforcing or requiring enforcement of any other Security shall have the effect of releasing the Bank from its full liability hereunder.
9. It shall not be necessary for the Employer to proceed against the said Contractor before proceeding against the Bank and the Guarantee herein contained shall be enforceable against the Bank notwithstanding that any Security which The Employer may have obtained or obtain from the Contractor shall at the time when proceedings are taken against the said bank hereunder be outstanding or unrealised.

10. We, the said Bank undertake not to revoke this guarantee during its currency except with the consent of the Employer in writing and agree that any change in the constitution of the said Contractor or the said bank shall not discharge our liability hereunder.
11. We _____ the said Bank further that we shall pay forthwith the amount stated in the notice of demand notwithstanding any dispute/difference pending between the parties before the arbitrator and/or that any dispute is being referred to arbitration.
12. Notwithstanding anything contained herein above, our liability under this guarantee shall be restricted to Rs. _____ (Rupees _____) and this guarantee shall remain in force till _____ which is after completion of 60 months of contract and unless a claim is made on us within 3 months from that date, that is before _____ all the claims under this guarantee shall be forfeited and we shall be relieved of and discharged from our liabilities there under.

FORM OF AGREEMENT
